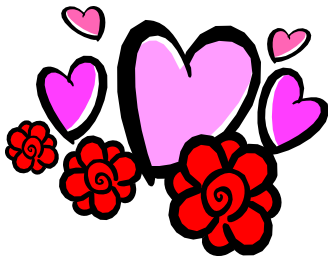

A Word From The President...

Captain's Cove Property Owner,

The primary developer of Captain's Cove (Captain's Cove Group LLC) has filed for Chapter 11 bankruptcy. This filing does not affect the financial operations of the Captain's Cove Golf and Yacht Club, Inc. (CCGYC) which is an entirely separate corporate entity. The CCGYC currently enjoys a strong financial position with more than adequate resources to fund our continued operations.

The Board of Directors of CCGYC, in carrying out its responsibility to act with due diligence to protect the rights and interests of all property owners in the Cove, has recently entered into an initial dialogue with both the developer and his primary lien holder, PNC Bank, in order to develop and review all available options for the CCGYC with respect to this situation. All available courses of action will be evaluated, including the costs of standing by and taking no action.

As various plans and options are developed, the Board will inform Cove members of progress. The goal of the Board throughout will always be to act in the best interests of all Cove members, and protect the uniqueness, financial stability and excellence of our community. Thank you for your consideration on behalf of the Board of CCGYC, Inc.
