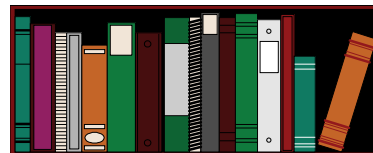
We will keep you posted on "the move" when it is scheduled. Those who have offered to help, we will be in touch!
