Looks like our back bay has met its course and slowed down the fishing bite. An occasional flounder with still many small croaker. The one fun thing to do is to fish light tackle, bait up a hook and shark fish just do not forget that metal leader. Looking forward to rocktober. Been bouncing back and forth from Crisfield fishing the edge of the channel in front of buoy #9 and the puppy hole, catching my one flounder and some nice croaker. The Ocean City inlet and north and south bays have still been fisherman friendly with plenty of fish in the waters. Seems like the best place close to fish. Our beach surf fishing is slow with some spot and a couple of kingfish being caught. This coming surf season I am going to start a club for those who like to surf fish and keep others informed on catches and tackle tips. It is nice to fish with a group of friends. Stay tuned! It is now time to be really offshore, if you can get out. The wrecks have still been holding some nice size flounder, sea bass and

trigger fish. OFF, OFF shore, the action has been great with this very warm water bringing in some big fish. Two new records in Maryland have been set for Blue Marlin, 1062 lbs., took 3 hours plus to bring it in and a Cobia, 72 lbs., WOW!! We had the White Marlin Open the beginning of August with some nice fish being caught. First place was a 93.5 lb. white marlin and of course "big blue" won its division. The ponds are a little tough to fish, not many bass hitting top water and a lot of grass making it hard to bounce plastics on the bottom! Stiff Lines and Busy Nets,
